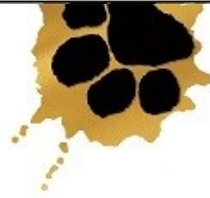

Welcome



Hello there, *Evening of Pawsibilities* attendees! Welcome to our 20th annual—and first-ever virtual—auction for the animals of Second Chance Pet Adoptions! Though we’ve had over 7 months now to wrap our minds around the arrival of this “new reality,” it still feels ever-so-strange to be welcoming you into this event through a PDF on the internet rather than with a program booklet handed to you, our esteemed guest, by one of our smiling volunteers upon entrance.

It is my sincere hope that, on your side of the screen, all is as well as can be with you and yours. Words can’t express how grateful I am that you are “here” with us as we rally to show you a good time this week.

It’ll come as no surprise: 2020 brought with it many challenges for Second Chance Pet Adoptions. For months on end, the animals at our adoption center were cared for by the same small crew of individuals as we did our best to reduce the number of bodies in the building at any given time. Though they were selfless, they (as flesh-and-blood human beings with families and jobs) were not tireless, and there was much relief when we could welcome the return of additional volunteers. Calendar apps worked overtime to keep up with the scheduling of appointments for what used to be casual walk-in occurrences before our front door was locked *and* the stream of Zoom links required to recreate both the *Evening of Pawsibilities* and our big spring 5K/ walk fundraiser, *Racing for Rescues*, as virtual events; meanwhile, dozens of fundraising and adoption events were nixed through the spring, then summer, and then fall, too.

No matter the challenges, love and support kept us afloat at this critical time; since the last *Evening of Pawsibilities*, Second Chance has saved over 800 stray and abandoned cats and dogs, bringing our total since our 1987 inception to around 15,000 second chances given! Another 103 dogs were rescued from county shelters through our Hearts to Home transport program and sent to our partner rescues to find their forever families in VA, MD, DE, NJ, and PA. And, 441 cats and 40 dogs owned by folks in need of financial assistance or cared for by good Samaritans looking out for feral colonies were spayed/neutered with funds provided by Second Chance. So much more than COVID-19 has granted 2020, its rightful place in Second Chance’s history.

Undeniably, these 2020 successes were the outcome of the generous support received from the 2019 *Evening of Pawsibilities* bidders and donors. Now, your bids and donations in *this* year’s virtual event will set our staff and volunteers up to grant more second chances to homeless animals on your behalf in 2021. We thank you, our partners in rescue, for joining us for this life-saving auction. I look forward to seeing you LIVE Nov. !!

The Auction

THE AUCTION OPENS AT 5:00 PM EASTERN OCTOBER 29 & CLOSES AT 7:30 PM EASTERN NOVEMBER 1, 2020

All building takes place through the GiveSmart platform. With your computer, tablet, or phone, you can use GiveSmart to place your bids, purchase items, or donate to the animals. You do not need a special app, only an internet browser like Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Internet Explorer, or Microsoft Edge.

Creating an account is free so you can browse at your leisure, though you will be prompted to enter your credit card information before any bid, purchase, or donation. You will not be charged at that time (unless you'd like to check out at that time); you do not have to check out until after the event, and when you do check out, you do not have to pay by credit card. If you prefer to pay with cash or a check, that will be an option post-event. However, Second Chance does reserve the right to charge your credit card for your auction items, purchases, and donations if you have not paid by December 1, 2020 (please contact us to pay later).

HOW TO BID AND DONATE

USING *GiveSmart*

Getting started

Begin at <http://2020paws.givesmart.com> in your browser. Depending on your activity to date, you may need to register for the 2020 *Evening of Pawsibilities* or sign into GiveSmart. **NOTE:** Registering, but don't have a cell phone? No problem! Simply email Rachel@SecondChanceNC.org with your full name and email address.



How to bid

Click "**ITEMS**" in the menu (top left) to be taken to All Items. You can browse them all or search using a word or item number. You can also select a category or click on "My Items" to see those you've added to your watch list (using the "Watch This Item" button with the star, which turns yellow once you're watching the item), bid on, or purchased. Click on an item you would like to bid on, enter the amount, and press "bid."

"Can GiveSmart bid for me?"

Whether you'll be otherwise occupied when the auction closes or you want to safeguard against forgetting, a dead battery, or simply having too many items to bid on at the last second, GiveSmart can be your personal shopper! Click on an item, then click "Auto Bid" to set your maximum bid to keep you winning automatically until you've been outbid at your maximum bid and need to enter a new maximum bid.

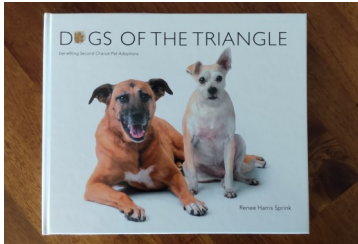
Have you been outbid?

If your cell phone number is in the system, you'll receive a text message the moment you're outbid! The banner across your item will also change colors. You can place a new bid via text or through your browser.

Want to donate to the animals?

Simply click on [Items 1-7 or on the button "\\$"](#) and enter an amount. Your name will show up on the big screen when we go live for the finale! (Or, you can choose to remain anonymous.)

NOTE: ALL links are personal to YOUR account. Do not share any!



Buy-Now Items

You may notice that not all items in GiveSmart are auction items—some have a purple “Buy Now” banner on them (especially items numbered in the 700 series in GiveSmart). This means that you do not have to bid on those items; rather, you will pay a set price and know that the item is yours without competition from other bidders!

Some of these items have a quantity of 1 per listing while others have several per listing. Make sure to purchase the ones that catch your eye sooner rather than later; once they’re sold, they’re sold!

The Wine Pull

Find your new favorite wine! For \$25, buy a Wine Pull (items in the 800 series in GiveSmart, also categorized in Wine Pull). Per the listing you select, you will be randomly assigned a bottle of red or white wine (white includes white, sparkling, and rosé) that will be worth anywhere from \$20 to \$70. You can purchase as many as you’d like... but hurry—quantities are limited!



Our Shipping Policies

- The raffle prize will be delivered via email.
- The costume contest prizes can be sent to the winner (at no additional cost) via mail (U.S. only).
- Those who win/purchase ONLY gift cards, jewelry, greeting cards, *Dogs of the Triangle* books, Modern Christmas Trees, or a combination of the above can have their items sent via mail (at no cost to you; U.S. only); please note that the items may ship as late as November 13, 2020.
- All other items must be picked up by the winners, or someone sent on their behalf, in Raleigh, NC by January 15, 2021; unless otherwise discussed, items not picked up by January 15, 2021 will be considered donated back to Second Chance Pet Adoptions for use in future fundraising efforts.
- Items containing wine, liquor, or beer cannot be shipped under any circumstances.
- If there is an item (outside of those named above) that you are interested in but would need shipped, please email Rachel@SecondChanceNC.org (and include the item number) **before** you place your bid to inquire about the possibility of shipping. We will accommodate any request that we can, but please know we are prioritizing our ability to safely ship your item (without damage) and the preservation of resources for animals; an offer to cover the cost of shipping would be appreciated and helpful.

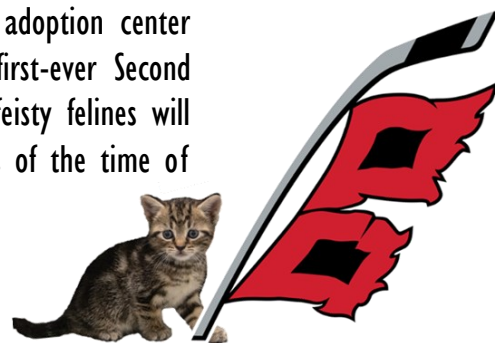

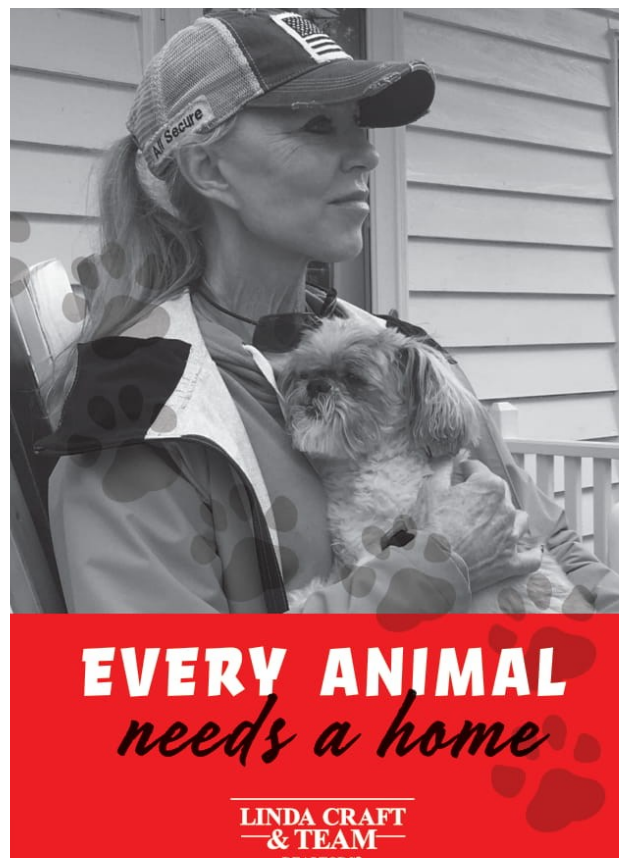
