Welcome to the 21st annual—and first-ever hybrid—Second Chance Pet Adoptions *Evening of Pawsibilities!* This year's auction fundraiser is supported by guests joining us in the ballroom as well as remote participants who are getting in on the fun through the live stream. No matter where you are on September 18, we are grateful to count you among the event attendees. Our steering committee has worked hard to show you a great time for a great cause, so thank you for being here, there, and everywhere!

I'm so thrilled to share that, after last year's fully-virtual *Evening of Pawsibilities*, Second Chance has had a phenomenal past 12 months; our staff and volunteers rescued almost 1,100 stray and abandoned cats and dogs, mostly from overcrowded animal shelters. Of those, we found local adoptive homes for almost 700, and we sent an additional 200 to our partner rescues up north so they could find their forever families through our *Hearts to Home* transport program. Our *Heeling Hearts* program gave life-saving treatment for heartworm disease to 44 dogs, and in addition to spaying/neutering all the animals in our adoption program, we also provided funding for spay/neuter surgeries for over 400 more animals in our community to more proactively combat animal homelessness

All of this was made possible by those who bid, bought, and donated through our 2020 *Evening of Pawsibilities*. This event is fun, but it's also vitally important to the welfare of innocent animals. It's life-changing and it's life-saving, and we thank you for your investment in the mission to end animal homelessness and give all cats and dogs the second chances they deserve.





HOW TO BID

USING GiveSmart

Getting started

First, make sure you've stopped by the Check-In table once you arrived—our volunteers will ensure your GiveSmart account is ready to go!

How to start bidding

Click the link in your welcome text and it will take you to your own personal bidding page. Click on an item you would like to bid on. Enter the amount and press the green "Bid" button.





"Can GiveSmart bid for me?"

Whether you don't have a phone or your battery died (our charging station may come in handy), a volunteer can help! Ask a Check-In volunteer to assist you throughout the event. Or, perhaps you're busy mingling? Click on an item, then click the "Auto Bid" tab to set your max bid to keep you winning automatically until you've been outbid and need to enter a new bid.

Have you been outbid?

You'll receive a text message the moment it happens!

Did you win?

When the auction is over, you will receive a text message letting you know if you won the item(s) you bid on. Your message will also include payment instructions for a quick, convenient, and secure check-out.

Want to donate to the animals?

Simply click on the button "\$" and enter an amount, or text "give" and amount (example: "give 100") to 76278. Your name will show up on the big screen at the front of the room! (Or, you can choose to remain anonymous.)
