



## HOW TO BID

## USING GiveSmart

## **Getting started**

Open a browser on your laptop, phone, or tablet and navigate to 2022eop.givesmart.com. Click the registration button to participate without a ticket.

### How to start bidding

Click the link in your welcome text and it will take you to your own personal bidding page. Click on an item you would like to bid on. Enter the amount and press the "Bid" button.



## "Can GiveSmart bid for me?"

Through the magic of mobile bidding, you can bid in the silent auction whether you're at home, on a business trip, at a football game, etc. If you're busy and unable to watch your items all night, just set a max bid! Click on an item, then click the "Auto Bid" tab to set your max bid to keep you winning automatically until you've been outbid and need to enter a new bid.

## Have you been outbid?

You'll receive a text message the moment it happens!

## Did you win?

When the auction is over, you will receive a text message letting you know if you won the item(s) you bid on. Your message will also include payment instructions for a quick, convenient, and secure check-out.

### Want to donate to the animals?

Simply navigate to the Items page and click on the button "\$" at the very top. Enter an amount and hit the "Donate" button. Your name will show up on the big screen at the front of the room! (Or, you can remain anonymous.)
