The trend that began last year—shelters filling up faster than

they had in prior years since animals were no longer going home with adopters or into foster care at the same rates—has sadly continued into 2023. It's always been harder to place large animals, animals with extraordinary medical needs, and animals with behavioral quirks into foster care or adoptive homes, but lately it's been hard to place even the small, healthy, well-mannered animals, too. Our partner shelters are desperate for rescues like ours to continue pulling animals to make room for more, so we're doing all we can to save every life possible. 

HOW TO BID

USING GiveSmart

Getting started

First, make sure you've stopped by the Check-In table once you arrived—our volunteers will ensure your GiveSmart account is ready to go!

How to start bidding

Click the link in your welcome text and it will take you to your own personal bidding page. Click on an item you would like to bid on. Enter the amount and press the "Bid" button.



"Can GiveSmart bid for me?"

Absolutely! To ensure you miss nothing while you're exploring our activities, visiting with animals, and making memories with friends, set an auto bid! Click on an item, then click the "Auto Bid" tab to set your max bid (the most you'd like to commit to at this time) to keep you winning automatically until you've been outbid and need to enter a new bid.

Have you been outbid?

You'll receive a text message the moment it happens!

Did you win?

When the auction is over, you will receive a text message letting you know if you won the item(s) you bid on. Your message will also include payment instructions for a quick, convenient, and secure check-out.

Want to donate to the animals?

Simply navigate to the Items page and click on the button "\$" at the very top. Enter an amount and hit the "Donate" button. Your name will show up on the big screen at the front of the room! (Or, you can remain anonymous.)
